# Kernels Popcorn

Popcorn is sold at first nutrition break on the final Friday of the month for \$2.50/bag. Available flavours are: butter salt, white cheddar, dill pickle, salt and vinegar and low fat caramel.

**New this year!** To make things easier for our youngest Thunderbirds, popcorn may be pre-purchase for students in Kindergarten to Grade 2 through the **hotlunches.net** platform. Online orders are due the night before popcorn day. Please be aware than any unpaid orders will be deleted.

Please note that we are <u>unable to provide refunds</u> for hot lunches that are missed by your student(s). We understand that things come up and illnesses happen, but unfortunately due to us having to order from vendors in advance we cannot cancel an order once the due date has passed and we must pay for all food that arrives at the school. *Thank you for your understanding and for supporting our fundraisers.* 


## Registering for Hotlunches.net

To participate in lunches and other fundraisers during the year you will need to create a **Hotlunches.net** account for your family. All user accounts are deleted annually due to privacy laws, so <u>you must re-register this year</u>. If you have a credit balance from last year, that balance will automatically be added to your account based on your registration information.

Registration and ordering is simple and will take about 5 minutes.

- Fill out the required information and click "Register Now"






Once registered you will be automatically directed to a welcome screen where you can add your students.

• Click "Insert". Repeat this process for all of your students by clicking "Add New".


Once you've added a student you can start placing orders. You can place orders for all your students and multiple hot lunches before making a payment.
